CONCLUSIONS

- 1) Gender equality should be demonstrated in equal representation of both genders in decision-making positions of sports organizations. The aim is to achieve 50% of representation of both genders by 2020.
- 2) The International Olympic Committee should launch the empowerment programmes for the underrepresented gender with the view of equal participation in the realization of sports-related action plans and national strategies.
- 3) Gender equality issue is not exclusively women's problem; it should receive the support of all stakeholders.
- 4) The access to sports infrastructure, education and employment should be equal for both genders under the same conditions.
- 5) Equal access to the funds, competitions, preparations and decision-making will enable equality of both genders within the entire sports movement.
